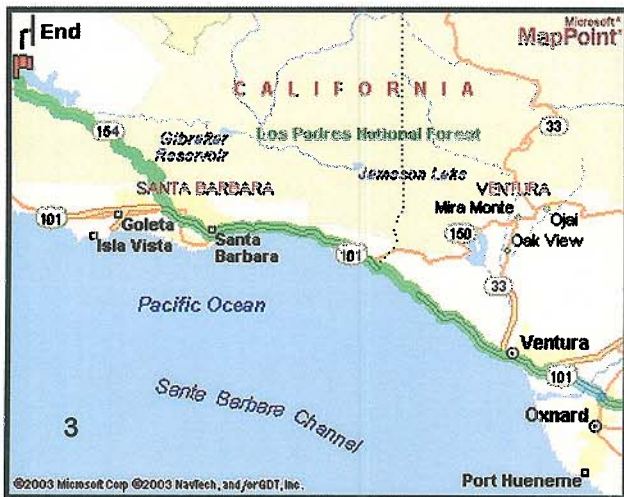
MAPS and Directions to Campsite.



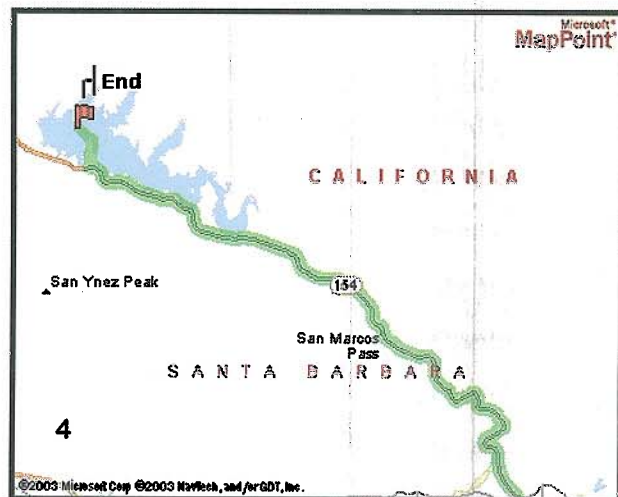
A brief overview. From the South Bay to Cachuma Lake is about 2 hours or approximately 145 miles. Depending on traffic and how you drive.



Now from P.V. take the 110 N (Harbor Fwy) to the 405 N (San Diego Fwy) to the 101 N (Ventura Fwy). I suggest that you leave early, if possible, to avoid traffic.



Take Hwy 101 N through Santa Barbara and look for the San Marcos Pass exit. (Hwy 154 N)



Take the San Marcos Pass exit (154 North) directly to Cachuma Lake. Our campsite name is Apache Trail. Tell the Ranger at the gate that you are with Pack 922.
